#### BOTTOM LINE

Dillon played right safety in the game. Generally, the action was away from his side of the field. When the play did come to his side, he was always around the ball. He was very good in coverage. Aggressive in defending against the receiver and was never out of position. He rarely let a receiver get behind him. However, he seemed tentative to make a tackle. He was in on a play that ripped the ball loose from the receiver, but Baltimore recovered the ball. He almost had an interception in the fourth quarter. The ball was bouncing around in the air, but he could not get it before going out of bounds. His position kept him from making an impact in the run game.

#### BOTTOM LINE

Dillon swapped between safety (both left and right) and right cornerback in the game. Adequate tackler. However, he made a good hit for a solo tackle in the first quarter on a short pass to Tom Rychlec (#81). He also made another solo tackle in the middle of the field late in the second quarter. Quick to recognize and react to run/pass. Good in coverage, but did not help the cornerback on the deep ball. He let a receiver get very deep on him in the second quarter. The receiver caught the ball and was downed near the Packer goal. He was not responsible for that receiver (cornerbacks man), but would have liked to see him peel off of his guy to help downfield. He was not overly aggressive moving forward on the run, but he moved forward on that play, which allowed the receiver to get behind him.
